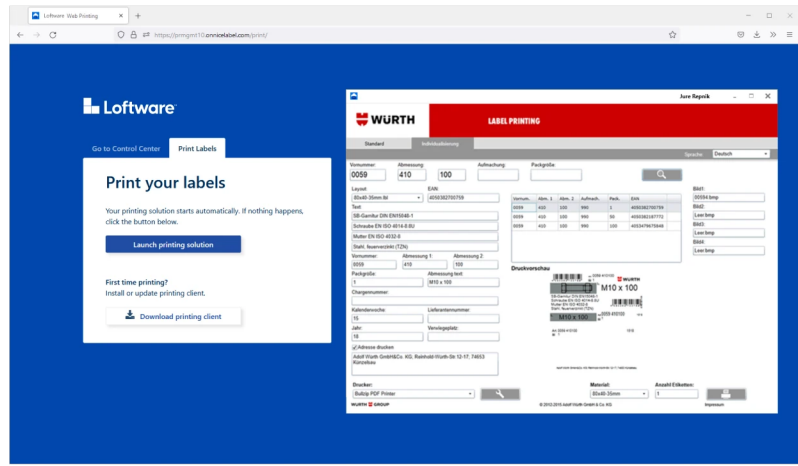


Print labels on-demand

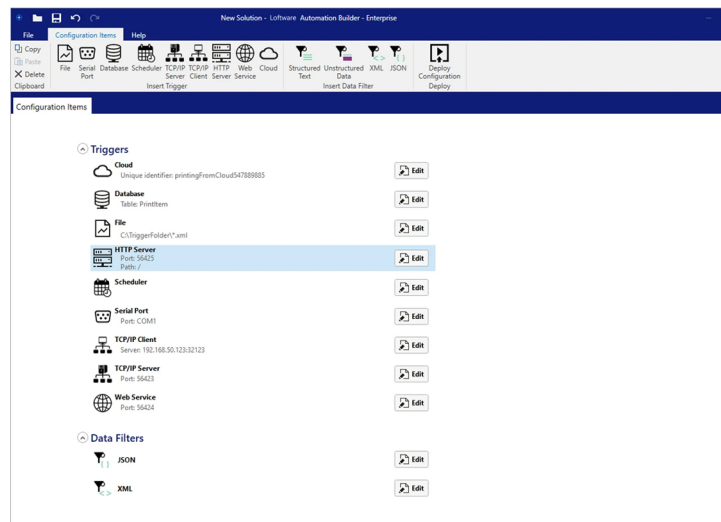
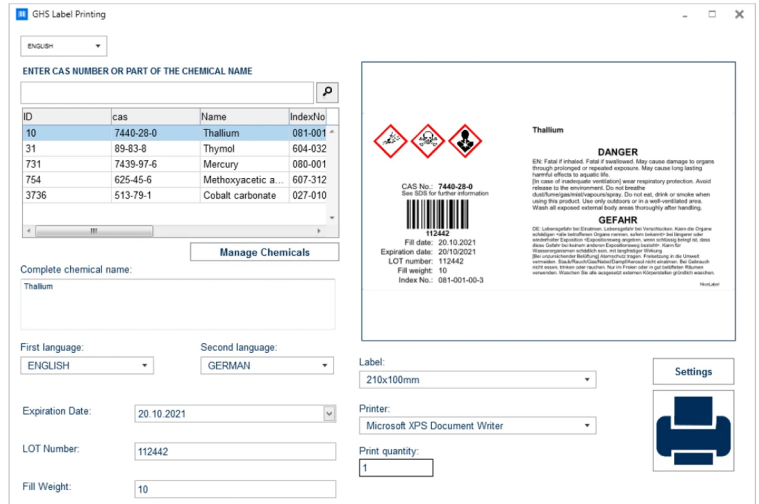


Build applications without coding

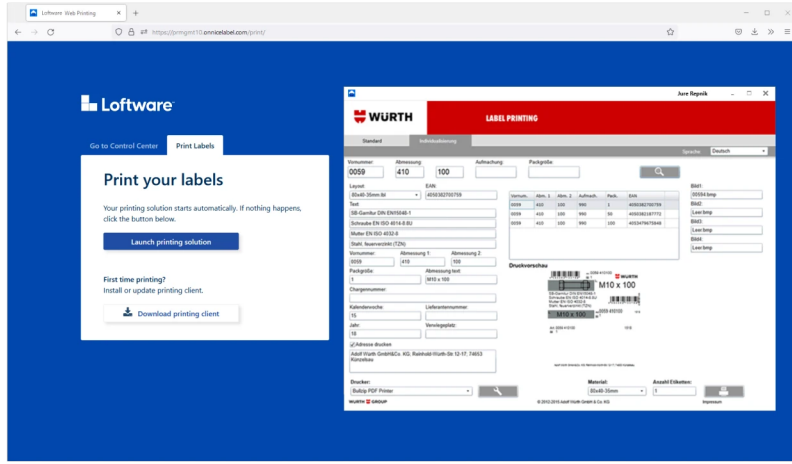


Add limitless flexibility with business rules

Our business rules engine allows print requests to be dynamically changed based on business logic applied to dynamic data. By processing the data, the business rules engine can select the applicable workflow to run and execute the logic to perform e.g. requesting data from additional data sources, manipulating and modifying label data, setting attributes, selecting one or many label templates, targeting specific printers, and executing additional workflows.
